### Quick Facts about the St. Marys Lions Club

April 1940 - Chartered with 45 members

In the 1990's they developed the St. Marys Lions Park (\$30-40 thousand purchase).

They donated \$15,000 towards the Walk Way. Today walkers can investigate their beautiful "Stonetown" going for miles on finished trails.

The St.Marys Lions now have an Annual Toll Bridge to raise money. In 2011 proceeds went to a local teen for a cornea transplant operation. In 2012 the proceeds went to the St Marys Skate Park.

Their third annual Car Show/Craft show went off without a hitch this year despite traffic construction.

They hold an annual International Breakfast held each year on the last Saturday in October.
