Items to Help Your Club:

Lions Clubs and Credit Cards

Most people use debit and credit cards for the majority of their financial transactions. Is your club ready to accept them? How about your District: can your Lions register and pay online to attend your District Convention?

So how does a Lions Club become able to accept credit cards? Your club's banker maybe able to give you options, but most "merchant accounts" are geared toward businesses that have a large number of transactions per month that spread-out the month charges. Filling this void for smaller operations are several services like Square and pay-pal.

While we are not endorsing these programs, they are options for your club to be able to accept credit cards. Let's take a look at Paypal: the most commonly used service.

With a PayPal account, your club can accept payments through four different methods:

- 1. Online---using your club's website to accept donations, register for events, etc.
- 2. Swipe---with a smartphone or tablet you can swipe the card. People can then use their cards with you at club events.
- 3. Invoices---you can email invoices to donors or members that allow them to pay the invoice electronically through the web.
- 4. Manually enter card number: you can take cards numbers and information over the phone and enter it into Paypal online. There is a larger charge for taking credit/debit cards through this method.









PayPal can be added to our website as a "widget".

It could be used as a method of receiving donations from anyone around the world at any time.

Paypal is not free: it charges a percentage of each transaction:

Online transactions and Invoices:

- 2.9% + \$0.30 per transaction (\$3.20 / \$100)
- 2.2% + \$0.30 per transaction for 501(c)3 ONLY (\$2.50 / \$100)

Swiped Transactions:

• 2.7% per transaction (\$2.70 / \$100)

Manually entered credit card through web:

• 3.5% + \$0.15 per transaction (\$3.65 / \$100)

These fees add up. So, be prepared to include the fees in the pricing of the items you plan to accept credit card.

Each service has different sign-up requirements, but generally you need the following items when signing your club up:

- 1. An individual club leader that will be the contact and guarantor of the account. Normally, this person must provide their tax id number (social security number)
- 2. A physical address for the club. Maybe the individual's home address.
- 3. The Club's Employer Identification Number
- 4. A linked checking account. Funds will be automatically deposited and reverses deducted from this account..

Paypal's website gives step by step directions to setting up "buttons" on your website for making payments. We encourage you to check it out for more details.

Your club or district's leadership should consider the costs and benefits of making these new payment methods available. The day of physical checks is passing quickly.

Cost is \$10.00 per car also there is a \$5.00 per member charge for the event (includes lunch)

The \$ 10.00 includes the KubKar kit and a donation to the prize pool. If your club already has a car from previous Rally Race, you only have to pay the \$ 5.00 entrance fee + lunch fee.

RULES

- The car must be built from the materials in the kit (no wheel bearings)
- Car dimensions must not exceed 70mm (2 ¾") WIDE, 180 mm (7") LONG, and 102mm (4") HIGH and must have clearance between the body and running surface of at least 10 mm (3/8")
- Front and rear wheels must be a minimum of 45mm (1 ¾"). Only 4 wheeled vehicles are permitted.
- The car can NOT weigh more than 142g (5 oz) or less then 85g (if it does not have enough weight it won't go down the track) Weight can be added between

front and rear axles, but must be flush with the bottom of the car.

- Cars will be weighed at registration and the winning cars will be weighed after the last race.
- Stickers and decals can be used.
- The car may be lubricated with any lubricant chosen by the builder, but no lubricant may be added after the car has been weighed in.
- We will have a 3 slot track, so each Zone will race against the other two zones.
- Car and race number will be drawn at registration. Cars must be registered before start of racing.

Champion of the Day will be awarded. Lion Trigger is the defending champ.
