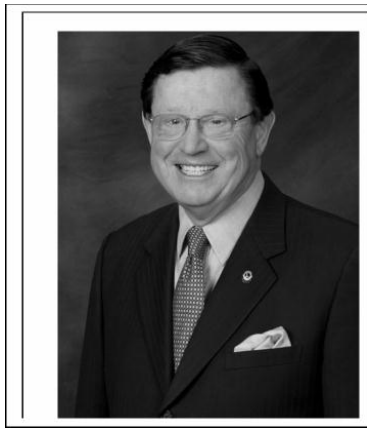

a BEACON of hope



On the Outer Banks of my home state of North Carolina, stands the world's tallest brick lighthouse. The Cape Hatteras lighthouse, built in 1807, has stood as a symbol of hope for mariners for over two centuries. Atlantic currents in this area made for excellent travel for ships, except in the area just offshore at Cape Hatteras. Nearby, the warm Gulf Stream ocean current collides with the colder Labrador Current, creating ideal conditions for powerful ocean storms and sea swells. The beacon at Cape Hatteras has been credited with guiding ships to safe harbor - pointing the way for thousands who thought all hope was lost. In spite of modern navigational aids and onboard satellite systems, lighthouses still dot the shores of oceans around the world.

They have stood the test of time, and remain symbols of hope for those who have lost their way or are in need of assistance. The lighthouse keeper who used to manually light a lamp at the top of the lighthouse has long been replaced, but the light is still relevant.

Helen Keller asked the Lions to help her bring light to others. We answered that call as no other organization could, and our light of service is more relevant today than ever before. Yes - technology has added convenience to our lives, and we are all thankful for medical advances that have improved quality of life, and in many cases have made it possible to eradicate diseases that have plagued humankind. But in spite of advances far too numerous to mention, that have made our lives better, nothing has replaced the need for human interaction. There is no substitute for an outstretched hand offered in service.

Built on a solid foundation of volunteer service, Lions Clubs International has been providing hope to those in need since 1917. Throughout our history, Lions have been shining a light, highlighting health and happiness for millions of people living in darkness and despair. There is a light that emanates from each and every Lion member. You can see it in their eyes, you can see it in their smile, and you can see it in their actions.

 - A-1 Youth Camp
 - Lions World Day Service
 - Diabetes

DICK KENNEDY VISITATION CONTEST

The Dick Kennedy Visitation Contest is held annually to encourage more visits by Club members, thus bringing A-1 closer together. Governor's Official visits are not included. Visitation contest is the current Lions year, July 1 to June 30.

1. For each member accompanying VDG, Region or Zone Chair on official visits 5
2. For each member visiting a Club in own Zone for any function (Minimum 2 members) 10
3. For each member visiting another Club in another Zone, for any function (minimum 2 members) 15
4. For each member visiting another Club in another District at least 40 km away, any function (min 4 members) 20
5. For each member visiting a Lions Club 500 miles (800 km) away from home Club (must have proof of visit) 20
5. The Dick Kennedy Award will be given to the top Club in A-1. Banner patches will be given to the top Clubs in each Region.

(NB - To receive points, the information must be on the monthly reports for the month involved)

MEMBERSHIP CONTEST

All Clubs in District A-1 are entered. The Club with the largest percentage (%) increase in membership will be presented with an award. The percentage will be tabulated from monthly reports from July 1 to June 30 of the current fiscal year.

Example #1: If a Club shows 15 members on July's monthly report and 18 on June's monthly report, the increase of 3 members is equal to 20%.

Example #2: If a Club shows 50 members on July's monthly report and 53 on June's monthly report, the increase of 3 members is equal to 6%.

The Club with the 20% increase (Example #1) would receive the Membership Award.

LIONS DISTRICT A1 BULLETIN CONTEST
Maximum possible score 100

Format - 5 points

Only five (5) points are allotted to the format so that clubs which can spend \$1000 or \$10 will have equal chance to win. We hope this will encourage more participation.

The main requirement for the format (cover page) is to identify the name of the club, bulletin editor's name and address, the district, region and zone number must be shown.

The format may also contain such other information which the club considers appropriate. The major emphasis will be placed on content.

The Contest runs from October to February inclusive and points will be awarded for three (3) categories.

PUBLICATION POINT SYSTEM - Editorial Content - 40 points

Pro-rated per issue during the contest period. Number of points awarded on publication during the contest is divided by the number of bulletins published during the contest period. (October to February)

Date, time, place and program for the next meeting	5 points
Report of local club activities and action by the board of Directors	5 points
Coming events & information at the Club, Region, District and International level	10 points
Constructive editorials	5 points
Personal news of members	5 points
Continuous receipt of bulletin	10 points

GENERAL EFFECT - 15 points

This is the overall general readability and style of the bulletin.

Bulletins are classified according to the size of the club (40 members and over, 39 members and under) and frequency of publication of bulletins (weekly, monthly, twice monthly)

Immediately following our District contest the winners and runners up are entered for competition at the Multiple District A level.

PDG ROB SPIERING LEADERSHIP AWARD

Criteria

1. Any Lion who through their dedication or commitment, either took a leading role, or encouraging others to take a leading role in providing Leadership to their Club, or the District
2. Any Lion who is always striving to learn and help others learn and progress
3. Any Lion who displays leadership by their actions, their commitment, consideration and compassion for others inside and outside the organization.
4. Any Lion who is a willing participant in Lions projects and prepared to step up and help lead the project to its completion.

This award is not limited to the current Lions year...in other words a Lion who has worked tirelessly in the past could also be recognized for their efforts and commitment.

The selection committee shall be chaired annually by the VDG and composed of the 3 Region Chairs, plus a St Thomas Club Rep, who are all voting members of this committee.

The 4 committee members of this subcommittee, as outlined above, shall submit at least one (1) name of a deserving Lion, to the VDG no later than 60 days prior to the date of the District Convention. The name of each nominee shall be accompanied in writing, listing the reason(s) for their nomination, having regard to, but not limited to the criteria outlined above. The VDG shall also be entitled to submit a name of a candidate to be considered for this award.

The VDG shall arrange for a meeting of this subcommittee, as soon as possible thereafter (either in person, or by email or whatever method is agreed upon) with a view to selecting one (1) recipient

Once the recipient is selected, the St. Thomas Club Rep will arrange to have the award properly engraved and prepared for presentation at the District A1 Convention, by the VDG, or their designate.
