Zone Chair 24 South – October 26, 2008

1. A Zone Advisory meeting was held in Strathroy attended by all but one club in the zone.
 - a. Each club reported varying degrees of activity over the summer and plans for the coming year.
 - b. One club stated their recruiting plans were not going to be focused on the younger adults in the community, but rather they would speak with members of their community who had older children, or children who were at the age they were considering leaving home. It was thought these people might now have the time available to them to offer their services to the community.
 - c. An Inter-club visit schedule was forwarded to the clubs in the Zone encouraging at least two visits per club, within the zone.
2. One club visit
 - a. The membership is down in this particular club, however retention does not appear to be an issue, a move out of the area and unfortunately deaths caused the reduction. The induction of a new member in September was a positive.
